### Outcomes of Youth with Disabilities



After graduation, it's an exciting new world for you. You may feel ready or a little bit scared of this new adventure. Either way, your school and Wisconsin want to hear what you are up to. We want you to stay in touch and let us know how you are doing.

#### The Survey

One year after you graduate or leave school, your school district will send you a letter. This letter will include:

- The purpose of the survey
- A copy of the survey questions

#### THEN

- ◇ Someone from your former high school or from St. Norbert College, representing your school, will call you and ask you the survey questions.
- ◇ The phone call will only take 8 - 10 minutes of your time.
- ◇ You can share how things are going and what types of things you are doing.

#### The Goal of the Survey

The goal of this survey is to improve the types of classes, programs and services teachers and schools provide to future students so more kids are prepared to go to college or enter high quality employment after high school, and to share this information with the adults who provide help for young adults the first few years after high school.



### Do Your Part Take the Survey!!!

Families, educators, policymakers and advocates all want to see more youth with disabilities go on to postsecondary education, find meaningful employment, and achieve success in the adult world. The survey information is required by the **U.S. Department of Education Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP)**. To gather and report this outcomes data, Wisconsin has developed this post high survey, and Wisconsin reports the outcomes results in their Annual Performance Report (APR) to OSEP and to the public.
